Once again the Clyde River Steamer Club is chartering the motor vessel COUNTESS OF BREADALBANE for an afternoon cruise. This year the excursion is to Tighnabruaich and Kames. The pier at Kames which was used in former days by Clyde steamers is in a very decayed state and is incapable of use. Close beside it is Kames cargo pier and it is at this pier that COUNTESS OF BREADALBANE will tie up on Saturday 14 May, 1966. While sailing from Tighnabruaich to Kames, COUNTESS OF BREADALBANE will pass close to the third pier in the West Kyle - Auchenlochan.

Arrangements have been made for High Tea to be available on COUNTESS OF BREADALBANE, and also at Tighnabruaich Hotel and Kames Hotel. Reservations for High Tea should be made in advance, but PAYMENT FOR HIGH TEA SHOULD BE MADE TO CATERER ON DAY OF TRIP. The charge for High Tea on board the vessel will be 7/6 (children under ten years of age - half charge) and we have been assured that the hotel charges are reasonable. Passengers dining at Kames Hotel will require to make their own way from Tighnabruaich pier to the hotel (a distance of approximately two miles) and should rejoin the vessel at Kames pier.

In addition, Light Teas and Refreshments will be available in the ship's tearoom.

As usual, the numbers carried will be restricted and intending passengers are advised to BOOK EARLY, to ensure a ticket for this interesting excursion.

Booking opens 1 February, 1966.

The charterers reserve the right to alter or cancel the sailing detailed above.

All passengers are carried subject to the Conditions displayed in the offices and on board the vessels of The Caledonian Steam Packet Company Limited.

Persons using Kames cargo pier do so at their own risk.
