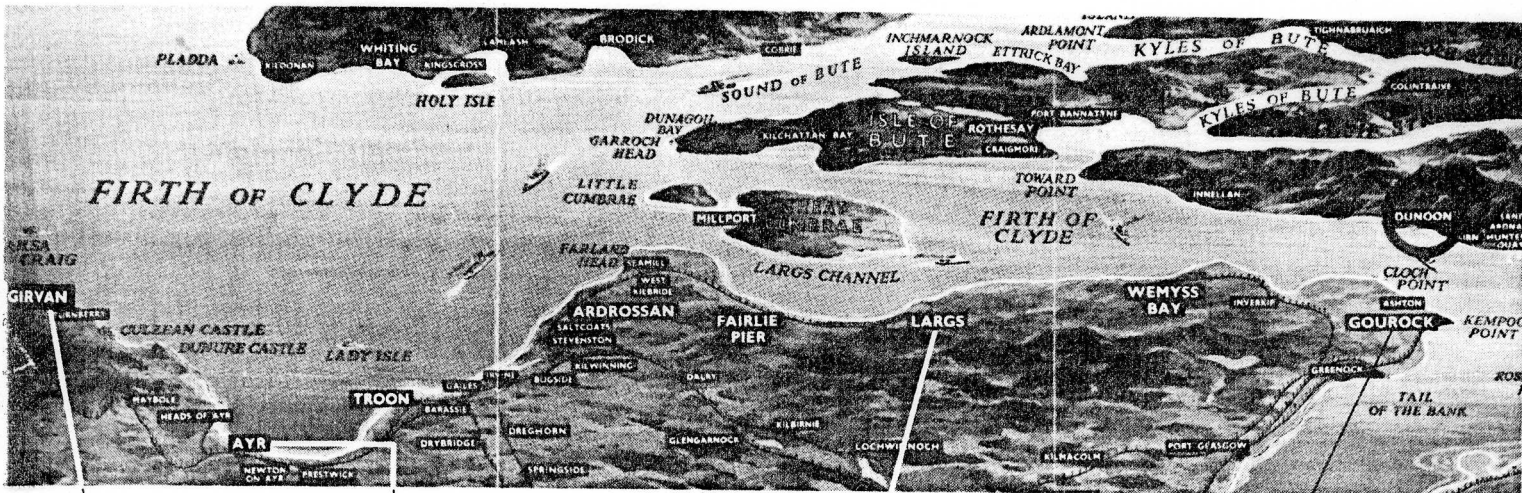

Return: A vessel will await the arrival of the steamer at Gourock to convey passengers back to Craigendoran.
