Members who wish to obtain permits to sail on the above date are requested to send a stamped addressed envelope (NOT SMALLER than $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ") to Mr. J. Robertson, 161, Maryhill Road, GLASGOW, G20 7XL. The authorisation is restricted to seventy persons. Applications will be numbered on receipt and dealt with in rotation. When the total number of interested persons is ascertained, quotations will be obtained from caterers. The Strathclyde Regional Council Sewerage Department will issue permit cards to the Club about the middle of June and thereafter full details will be sent to each successful applicant together with a permit card.

While it is gratifying that the Club should have again succeeded in obtaining the necessary authorisation from the Regional Council there is no reason to assume that this sail is now an annual event. Many organisations from several parts of the Strathclyde Region are keenly interested and, if the number of requests received by the Council continues to exceed the number of passenger sailings, the permit system may require to be reviewed by the Council.
