CALEDONIA from Oban to Craignure, and incorporating a return sailing in M.V. COLL between Tobermory and Mingary, crossing the Sound of Mull by M.V. ISLE OF CUMBRAE from Fishnish to Lochaline and crossing Loch Linnhe on the Corran Ferry. It is intended to allow time at Oban and Strontian for lunch and high tea respectively.
