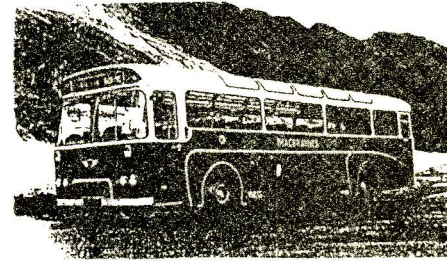
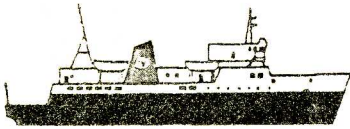


WEST HIGHLAND STEAMER CLUB
