The Club has been successful in obtaining a party sailing on board West of Scotland Water's vessel "Garroch Head" on Monday 2 June. The ship sails from Shieldhall Sewage Works shortly after 0800hrs down the Clyde to the dumping area south of Bute, then returns upriver normally arriving back at Shieldhall by 1630hrs.

No charge is made by West of Scotland Water for this sailing, however the Club Committee has decided to charge £10.00 and provide catering for **all passengers** on this sailing. The "Garroch Head" has a dining saloon, but it no longer has catering staff for passengers.

Private caterers will provide morning coffee; a buffet lunch; and afternoon tea.

72 passengers can be carried and club members wishing to travel must book in advance by completing the booking form below and sending it with a cheque for £10.00 per person by Saturday 24 May.

As a requirement of the Merchant shipping / Passenger Counting and Recording Systems Regulations 1990, on boarding the vessel each passenger must sign and surrender a Permit Card which will be issued prior to boarding on exchange of a CRSC ticket. **Please note that no passenger under the age of 16 will be allowed to board.**

Changes to the disposal of waste are likely to lead to an ending of the practice of dumping at sea and this may be the last opportunity given to the Club to travel on "Garroch Head". This, plus Monday 2 June being a holiday for some is likely to make this cruise extremely popular.

Early booking is therefore advisable. Bookings will be handled in strict order of receipt.
