Wednesday 12 July:

Small ship Cruising aboard "The Second Snark."

Starting at Greenock at 0935 the "Snark" sails via Helensburgh, Kilcreggan, Dunoon, Rothesay, Largs and Millport to Dunagoil Bay in the south west of Bute. Discount prices for Senior Citizens.

Sunday 23 July:

Cal-Mac cruise to Tarbert.

Take advantage of the day cruise from Gourock(0945) or Largs

(1105) to Tarbert with over two hours ashore.

Wednesday 9 August:

The long day cruise to Oban.

Cruise aboard mv "Isle of Arran" on her last season sailing from Kennacraig to Oban via Islay and Colonsay. A 0815hrs start and 2145hrs return makes a very long day, especially if driving from Glasgow, but the reward is a magnificent cruise up the west coast.

Sunday 27 August:

ps"Waverley" to Carrick Castle and Loch Long

Celebrate the return of "Waverley" after her rebuild with a cruise from Glasgow (1100), Greenock or Helensburgh to the area

she was originally built to serve.

Saturday 9 September:

my "Loch Nevis" cruise round the Small Isles

Another cause for celebration - the introduction of Cal - Mac's newest ship. She sails from Mallaig at 1235hrs for Eigg, Muck,

Rum, and Canna returning to Mallaig at 1950hrs.

Note: There are public transport connections outwards to

Mallaig, but not on the return.

Saturday 23 September:

my "Balmoral" to the Millport Illuminations

Round off another summer's cruising with the traditional afternoon and evening sail to Millport from Glasgow (1500).
