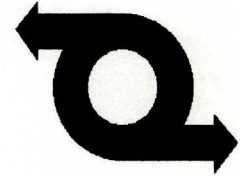

The Clyde River Steamer Club has chartered the new "Sound of Scarba" – the latest addition to the Western Ferries fleet – offering members a unique opportunity to cruise to the Gare Loch from Hunter's Quay and McInroy's Point.

The "Sound of Scarba" will depart from Hunter's Quay at 1900, and from McInroy's Point at 1930. Return to McInroy's Point will be around 2200, and Hunter's Quay at 2230. Times may be altered slightly to allow the regular ferry service vessel to arrive and depart without hindrance.

Tickets for this cruise must be purchased in advance, as numbers are limited by the vessel's seating capacity. These are available by post only from the Cruising Convenor at the address below, price £5 each. There is NO reduction for children. A stamped addressed envelope must accompany your booking for return of your tickets.

For members arriving by car, please note that parking at both terminals is very restricted, but is available along the main road in either direction.

Passengers are carried subject to the Conditions of Carriage of Western Ferries (Clyde) Limited.
The final destination of the cruise may be subject to alteration, dependant on circumstances.
