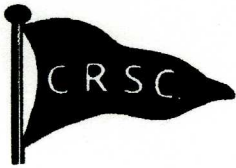

The Clyde River Steamer Club has chartered "The Second Snark" for a unique cruising opportunity on the lower Firth of Clyde, affording members the chance to obtain some unusual photographs.

"The Second Snark" will depart from Largs at 1000, and will head south for Ayr, where time ashore will allow members to stretch their legs. The timings will allow members to view the SeaCat catamaran departing from Troon Harbour, and also allow us to see the P&O freighter at the new ferry berth.

Following time ashore at Ayr, we shall head north again, arriving off Ardrossan in time to observe the "Caledonian Isles" sailing at 1515. From Ardrossan we shall continue northwards to Millport, where further time ashore will be available. Return to Largs will be at around 1820.

Tickets for this cruise must be purchased in advance. These are available by post only from the Cruising Convenor at the address below, price £20 each. A stamped addressed envelope must accompany your booking for return of your tickets.

**Please note that the final routing for this cruise is highly dependant on the weather, and will be solely at the discretion of the Master of the vessel.**

**In the event of inclement weather an alternative cruise will be offered, however, please be aware when booking that under no circumstances will any refunds be offered in such an eventuality.**
