"Shieldhall" will depart from Greenock Customhouse Quay at 1000, and will cruise up Loch Long, into Loch Goil, the Holy Loch and Cowal Coast, before sailing down the Largs Channel and around the Great Cumbrae. It is planned to have time ashore at Rothesay, before returning to Greenock at around 2000. During the cruise, teas, coffees, and light refreshments will be available.

Tickets for this unique day sailing must be purchased in advance - preference will be given to CRSC members when booking, as numbers are strictly limited. Tickets will be available by post only from the Cruising Convenor at the address below, price £30.00 each for adults, and £12.50 for children. A stamped addressed envelope must accompany your booking for return of your tickets.
