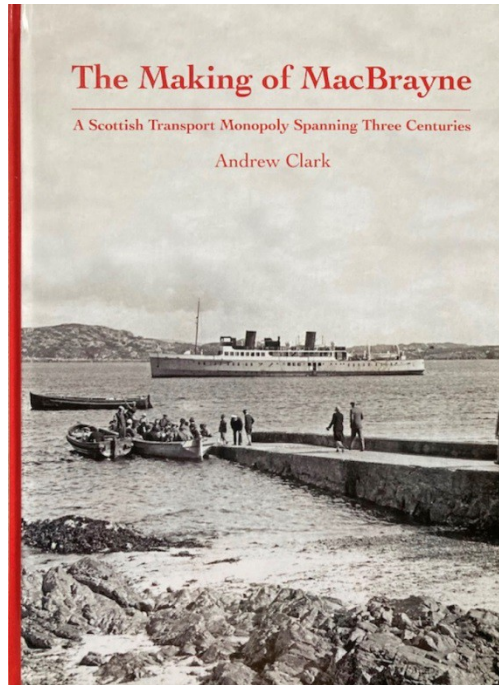


Andrew Clark’s epic history of David MacBrayne Ltd has been hailed as “the ultimate book for anyone with an interest in the history of west coast shipping.”
